

CLOUD COUNTY CHILDREN'S TRUST
GRANT FUNDS AVAILABLE

The annual meeting of the Advisory Committee of the Cloud County Children's Trust is scheduled for June 24, 2026 at The Citizens National Bank in Concordia. The Cloud County Children's Trust has funds available to assist children age 13 and under with special medical and developmental needs. Priority will be given to children with the greatest financial need.

INDIVIDUALS / FAMILIES

Funds may be applied for by individuals with children in need of services such as therapies including speech, physical and occupational, special medical equipment, transportation to and from medical treatment facilities, purchase of eyeglasses, hearing aids and payment of medical bills. Requests will be considered for children who were born in Cloud County, Kansas; whose mother was born in Cloud County; whose parents currently reside in Cloud County; or who currently reside in Cloud County. Individuals shall apply by completing an application for request available through The Citizens National Bank, Wealth Management. THERE IS NO DEADLINE FOR APPLICATIONS FROM INDIVIDUALS/FAMILIES.

Organizations / Professionals

Organizations and professionals serving eligible children may apply by submitting a typed letter of request and include:

- Description of Request
- Amount of Request
- Specific Reason for the Request
- Other sources of funding for the request, if applicable
- A copy of their **IRS 501(c)(3) tax-exempt status letter**
(Public schools, municipalities, and counties are exempt from this requirement)
- Requests from public entities must be **signed by the chief official** (Superintendent, Mayor, or County Commissioners)

Documentation Requirement

All organizations receiving funds must submit documentation showing how grant funds were spent. Instructions will be given at the time of the grant.
